#### **VOTING PLACES**

Voting Places will be open for voting on Wednesday, October 24, 2018, commencing at the hour of eight o'clock in the forenoon and continuing until eight o'clock in the afternoon of the same day: Flin Flon Community Centre, R.H. Channing Auditorium (Polls 1-6) and Northminster Memorial United Church (Polls 7-11).

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE. A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

# **ADVANCE VOTING**

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at City Hall, 20 First Avenue, on Wednesday, October 17, 2018, between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

## **MOBILE VOTING**

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility or a Seniors Facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the Northern Lights Manor, Flin Flon General Hospital, Rotary Court, Legion Housing, and Hemlock Housing on election day.

## **APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE (By Mail)**

An elector who is unable to go in person to the polling place or advance poll for an election, may apply in writing to the Senior Election Official no later than 3 days before Election Day, to vote by mail. Qualified electors who wish to vote by mail are encouraged to apply to the Senior Election Official at their earliest convenience.
